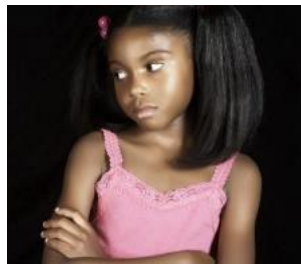


Children’s Mental Health Services

Qualified Mental Health Professionals and Community Support Specialists coordinate community support, crisis intervention, counseling, Parent-Child Interaction Therapy, Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, and psychiatric oversight. Services are provided in the home or in the community.

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS:

- Children ages 3 – 18 who have behavioral problems
- Requires Parent or Legal Guardian Signed Consent for services
- Child’s Social Security Number and Medicaid Number
- Most services are covered by Medicaid

BENEFITS TO PROGRAM PARTICIPATION:

- Community support, crisis intervention available 24/7, education on overall health and wellness, psychiatric medication management, individual and family counseling.
- Manageable treatment plan to help your child reach his or her potential.
- New coping skills to help the child manage their emotions.
- Improve school performance.
- Parenting skills and support to parents or guardian.

REFERRAL PROCESS:

1. Referral to YCPRC
2. Evaluation with a Qualified Mental Health Professional
3. Program Enrollment with a Community Support Specialist (case manager)
